

## Jesus, Our Tabernacle *a shelter like no other*

The Tabernacle was a movable tent that Almighty God commanded Moses to build according to specific plans printed out. A large brass basin of water stood between The Altar of Sacrifice and The Tent of Meeting in The Courtyard. The bronze laver and its base of bronze were made from the ***mirrors brought by "the women who served at the entrance to the tent of meeting."*** The women used highly polished brass and other metals. We are reminded of our Water/Word Baptism. Jesus is our Tabernacle, our High Priest, our Door, our Sacrificial Lamb, our Foot(Soul)washer – our Savior, Servant and Friend.

## Bronze Basin Where God Makes Us Clean

Hands lifted high to heaven and Feet grounded to earth.

Jesus washed sinners' feet with His holy hands.

Jesus' hands and feet were pierced. Psalm 22:

<sup>17</sup> When I (John) saw Him (Jesus), I fell at His feet as though dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying, ***"Fear not, I am the first and the last, <sup>18</sup> and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore..."*** Revelation 1

<sup>34</sup> Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? <sup>4</sup> We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." - Romans 6:3-4

<sup>18</sup> For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, <sup>19</sup> in which He went and proclaimed to the spirits in prison, <sup>20</sup> because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, ***were brought safely through water.*** <sup>21</sup> ***Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you,*** not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, <sup>22</sup> who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to Him. **1 Peter 3**
